

Phillips Plastics Scholarship Program

The Phillips Plastics Corporation® Scholarship Program gives a maximum of ten \$1,250 awards per-year to full-time students who have completed their first year in an accredited Associate, Baccalaureate, or Graduate degree program. Past recipients may reapply each year they are eligible.

Minimum Eligibility Requirements

- Completion of one year of college, trade, or technical school
- Cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (based on a 4.0 scale) or better
- Enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited degree program
- Participation in academic and/or non-academic extra curricular activities
- Dependent of Phillips Plastics person (see below for definition of dependents)
- Completed essay
- Have a financial need

To Apply

Candidates must have completed at least their first semester of college, trade, or technical school and not be receiving educational assistance through Phillips Plastics. In order to be considered, applicants must meet the minimum eligibility requirements by the date awards are issued. To assist the selection committee in knowing you better, a scholarship application must be completed and an essay (500 words or less), stating why you feel you should receive a Phillips Plastics Scholarship. Include purpose for going to college, future goals, career direction and an outline of your financial needs. You will need to provide two letters of reference from individuals familiar with your academic achievements, community service activities, or job/work performance.

Those eligible to apply must be dependent children of a regular part-time or full-time Phillips Plastics employee. Dependent children are defined as unmarried children supported by an employee/parent including natural children, adopted children, foster children and step-children. Only one Phillips Plastics Scholarship award will be made to a member of a Phillips Plastics employee family in any one scholarship year.

Applications are now available for fall semester scholarship awards at the front desk of any Phillips Plastics facility, from all People Service Representatives, and on Phillips Plastics' internal Web site (<http://ppcweb/>). Applications must be postmarked by April 1, 2010. Applications postmarked after April 1, 2010 will not be considered. Forward completed application, essay, letters of recommendation, and current official transcripts to:
